TRANSMITTER OPERATION

INSTALLING TRANSMITTER BATTERIES

This transmitter requires 4 AA batteries.

- 1. Open the battery cover.
- 2. Install the batteries as shown.
- 3. Close the battery cover.






CAUTION: NEVER remove the transmitter batteries while the model is powered on. Loss of model control, damage or injury may occur.

TRANSMITTER CONTROLS



- ON/OFF Switch Turns the power ON/OFF for the transmitter
- 2. Bind Button Connects transmitter to vehicle
- 3. Indicator Light
 - Green light—Indicates the transmitter is powered on.
- Steering Wheel Controls direction (left/right) of the model
- Throttle Trigger Controls speed and direction (forward/brake/reverse) of the model
- 6. Indicator Light
 - Red Charging light—Indicates the transmitter is connected to the vehicle and is charging the battery.
- 7. ST Trim Adjusts the steering center point



CHARGING WARNINGS

CAUTION: All instructions and warnings must be followed exactly. Mishandling of Li-Po batteries can result in a fire, personal injury and/or property damage.

- NEVER LEAVE CHARGING BATTERIES UNATTENDED.
- NEVER CHARGE BATTERIES OVERNIGHT.
- By handling, charging or using the included Li-Po battery, you assume all risks associated with lithium batteries.
- If at any time the battery begins to balloon or swell, discontinue use immediately. If charging or discharging, discontinue and disconnect. Continuing to use, charge or discharge a battery that is ballooning or swelling can result in fire.
- Always store the battery at room temperature in a dry area for best results.
- Do not store battery or model in a car or direct sunlight. If stored in a hot car, the battery can be damaged or even catch fire.

- Always charge batteries away from flammable materials.
- Always inspect the battery before charging.
- Always disconnect the battery after charging, and let the charger cool between charges.

VEHICLE PREPARATIONS

CHARGE THE BATTERY

CAUTION: Never exceed the recommended charge rate. The included transmitter has a built-in charger designed to safely charge the 1S 3.7V 200mAh Li-Po battery (ECX100017).

NOTICE: Inspect the battery to make sure it is not damaged e.g., swollen, bent, broken or punctured. Charge only batteries that are cool to the touch and are not damaged.




Insert the charge lead from the transmitter into the charge port on the side of the vehicle. The red LED on the top of the transmitter indicates charge status.

CHARGING (Solid Red LED)
MAX CHARGE (LED OFF)

Always disconnect the battery from the charger immediately upon completion of charging.

CAUTION: Once charging is complete, immediately disconnect the charge cord. Never leave a battery connected to the charger.

GETTING STARTED





- 2. Power on the transmitter. The green LED on the transmitter will stay illuminated when the transmitter connects to the vehicle.
- **3.** Perform a test of the transmitter's control of the vehicle with the vehicle's wheels off the ground.
- Start driving slowly, and, if the vehicle does not go straight, adjust the steering trim dial on the transmitter.

CAUTION: The Micro Roost and Micro Ruckus are intended for dry operating conditions. Do not drive the Micro Roost or Micro Ruckus in rain or on wet surfaces.

AFTER DRIVING

- 1 Power off the vehicle
- 2. Power off the transmitter.
- 3. Recharge the battery.

BIND PROCEDURE

- Press the Bind button on the transmitter and power it on. The transmitter red LED will flash for 20 seconds indicating it is in Bind mode.
- 2. Power the vehicle on while the transmitter is in Bind mode
- **3.** The LED on the vehicle will stay illuminated when binding is complete.



REPLACING THE BATTERY IN THE VEHICLE

- 1. Open the battery cover.
- **2.** Remove the battery and unplug it from the vehicle.
- 3. Plug the new battery into the vehicle
- 4. Insert the battery into the battery tray.
- 5. Close the battery cover.

CAUTION: Connecting the battery to the vehicle with reversed polarity will cause damage to the truck, the battery or both. Damage caused by incorrectly connecting the battery is not covered under warranty.
